



CLONE CARE BASICS

How to Care for Your New Clones

The clones you are receiving are cuttings that have been rooted in rockwool and potted up in 4" square pots in a sterile growing media. Clones should be transplanted once roots emerge from the pot and watered with a distilled water source. If you are going to use tap water, we suggest that you have it tested to understand the mineral/chemical content as well as the pH.

The clones are treated with neem oil (an OMRI-listed fungicide which may leave white residue on leaves) and beneficial insects to help combat and control major garden pests. Once clones are transplanted and watered into soil for about a week, you can begin to feed them with fertilizers, teas, or whichever nutrient technique you choose to employ.

These are mature plant cuttings and can be flowered right away depending on your overall grow room size, however we recommend giving them several weeks to grow and acclimate to your growing area before flowering.



Pricing & Availability

- Patients registered with the VMR can legally possess 7 immature and 2 flowering plants. Each patient can purchase up to 7 clones within a 30 day cycle.
- Clones are priced at \$25 each, or 5/\$100. Buy 7 clones at once and get one free potency test on your harvested flower through our Quality Control Lab.
- A limited amount of clones across a variety of cultivars are available each week on a first come first served basis at 3 of our dispensing locations: CVD in South Burlington and SVW in both Brattleboro and Middlebury. The selection varies based on our production schedule.
- Patients can purchase clones during their scheduled appointment or can pre-order online for express pick up. Home delivery is also available.
- To inquire about which cultivars are currently available, check the location specific, online menus on our website or call customer service at 844-283-9333, option 3.
- For those patients purchasing at the dispensaries, we recommend that you bring a suitable container to protect your clones from the elements during transport. Clones can be up to 15" tall, including potting container, at time of purchase.

Clone Return Policy

We do not offer returns or credits for clone purchases. Once the clone is inspected at the time of sale, deemed acceptable, and purchased, it becomes the property of the patient. CVD is not responsible for failed clones - please inspect your clones carefully!
